Your role during an emergency

On hearing an alarm sound you should do the following:

- Remain calm
- Stay where you are until directed by a staff member UNLESS YOU ARE IN IMMEDIATE DANGER
- Always be aware of your nearest exit (as indicated on the floor plan in each bedroom and as displayed throughout the nursing home)
- Be aware of the nearest fire door
- Be aware of the location of the fire extinguishers / hoses / break glass
- Assist where ever possible as directed by the chief fire warden (white hat) or fire warden (red hat).
