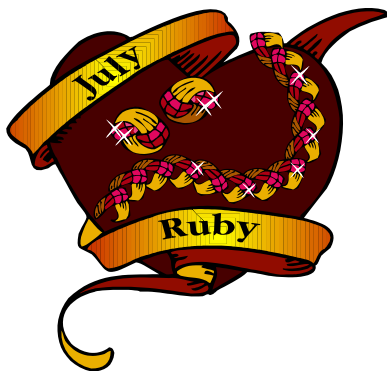

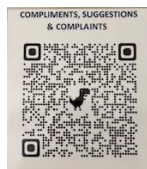
Previous Month Highlights – June

A short reminder to all residents, families and friends

Your role during an emergency

On hearing an alarm sound, you should do the following: Remain calm

- Stay where you are until directed by a staff member - **UNLESS YOU ARE IN IMMEDIATE DANGER**
- Always be aware of your nearest exit (as indicated on the floor plan in each bedroom and as displayed throughout our home)
- Be aware of where the nearest fire door is
- Be aware of the location of the fire extinguishers / hoses / break glass
- Assist wherever possible as directed by the chief fire warden (white hat) or fire Warden (red hat)
